1.	Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>The District comes out of the Aspiration district tag and comes at par with other districts of the State in terms of socio-economic development.</li><li>Per Capita Income of the District increases by 100%. Currently, it is 1,19,548.</li></ul>
2.	Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Learning levels of students increase by 50 % from the current level.</li><li>Male and Female literacy reaches 100% mark.</li><li>Increase in vocationalization of Education.</li><li>Promotion of digital education will be done to enhance learning levels and enrich learning experience.</li></ul>

Health & Sanitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Specialized health care is available in Medical College Chamba and referrals are minimum.</li><li>Primary health care is made available in all Civil Hospitals.</li><li>Water security is ensured by water harvesting and conservation. Incidence of water borne diseases is minimized.</li><li>Physical and mental health will be promoted through Aayush and Yoga.</li></ul>
4.	Women and Child Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All AWCs have Govt. accommodation. Currently this is 30% only.</li><li>Incidence of stunting, wasting and malnutrition is reduced by half.</li><li>Incidence of anemia is eliminated amongst adolescent girls and pregnant &amp; lactating mothers.</li></ul>
5.	Telecommunication	There is 100 % Mobile & High Speed Connectivity in the district. Currently more than 50 Panchayats have no mobile and internet connectivity. Most of the areas have 2G and poor connectivity.
6.	Roads Connectivity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>National Highway connectivity from Shahpur (Kangra) to Killar (Pangi) is provided.</li><li>Existing NH (Pathankot-Bharmour) is fully developed on the</li></ul>

Livelihood & Skill Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Horticulture, Agriculture &amp; Allied activities are able to contribute substantially for livelihood generation.</li> <li>• Micro irrigation is increased by 200 %.</li> <li>• Cash crops are promoted in big way in the district to increase farmers' income and standard of living.</li> <li>• Tourism activities reach remote areas of the district and it becomes one of the main sources of income employment generation.</li> <li>• Focus will be on promotion of adventure tourism.</li> <li>• New Tourism Destinations are developed for tourism promotion and increase the stay of tourists in the District.</li> <li>• Local crafts get national and international recognition.</li> <li>• Employability will be enhanced by skilling.</li> <li>• Focus will be shifting from wage employment to self-employment.</li> </ul>
