No.	Sector	
1.	Development	 The District comes out of the Aspiration district tag and comes at par with other districts of the State in terms of socio-economic development. Per Capita Income of the District increases by 100%. Currently, it is 1,19,548.
2.	Education	 Learning levels of students increase by 50 % from the current level. Male and Female literacy reaches 100% mark. Increase in vocationalization of Education. Promotion of digital education will be done to enhance learning levels and enrich learning experience.
3.	Health & Sanitation	 Specialized health care is available in Medical College Chamba and referrals are minimum. Primary health care is made available in all Civil Hospitals. Water security is ensured by water harvesting and conservation. Incidence of water borne diseases is minimized. Physical and mental health will be promoted through Aayush and Yoga.
4.	Women and Child Development	 All AWCs have Govt. accommodation. Currently this is 30% only. Incidence of stunting, wasting and malnutrition is reduced by half. Incidence of anemia is eliminated amongst adolescent girls and pregnant & lactating mothers.
5.	Telecommunication	There is 100 % Mobile & High Speed Connectivity in the district. Currently more than 50 Panchayats have no mobile and internet connectivity. Most of the areas have 2G and poor connectivity.
6.	Roads Connectivity	 National Highway connectivity from Shahpur (Kangra) to Killar (Pangi) is provided. Existing NH (Pathankot-Bharmour) is fully developed on the

7.	Livelihood & Skill Development	 NH norms. There is double laning of all roads connecting District with Sub-Divisional HQs. All Villages are connected by all weather roads. Major geographical barriers to access are overcome by construction of tunnels, particularly between Chowari and Chamba and Tissa and Pangi. Horticulture, Agriculture & Allied activities are able to contribute substantially for livelihood generation. Micro irrigation is increased by 200 %.
		 Cash crops are promoted in big way in the district to increase formers' income and standard of living. Tourism activities reach remote areas of the district and it becomes one of the main sources of income employment generation. Focus will be on promotion of adventure tourism. New Tourism Destinations are developed for tourism promotion and increase the stay of tourists in the District. Local crafts get national and international recognition. Employability will be enhanced by skilling. Focus will be shifting from wage employment to self-employment.
8.	Industry	 Hydropower potential of the district is fully harnessed. Industry based on handicraft, handloom and local biodiversity is promoted. Focus is on tourism industry.
9.	Environment and Ecology	 MSW, both at urban and rural areas is recycled and completely processed. Green cover of the district increases by 10%. Forest Fires are reduced by 50%. Use of clean and green energy for transportation and energy consumption is increased considerably. Septic and grey water management will ensured at all levels.
10.	Governance & Ease of Living	 All G2C Services are digitized and citizens get services online. All office process and records are also digitized. Robust Grievance Redressal Mechanisms are put in place.
11.	Disaster Management	 A robust early warning system for hydro-meteorological& geological disaster is put in place. Response capacity of the District to disasters improves considerably.
12.	Language and Culture	Local culture, language and heritage will be preserved and promoted.
